

Due to the most recent Covid guidelines issued by the CDC and NYS, relaxing Covid protocols in public places, these new procedures offer the next step toward returning to our pre-covid operations.

Proposed: Reopening Plan Phase 4B

These procedures reflect a “low” community level of COVID-19, determined by the CDC. Should the community level rise to “medium,” the procedures for the reopening plan would revert to Phase 4.

Public Access:

- Normal operating hours
- All members of the public will have access to the entire library without a requirement to wear masks.

Pick up and Drop Off:

- Returns may be made to either the outdoor book return box or the return drop at the circulation desk.
- Curbside service will be available by appointment for immune-compromised or elder patrons.

Services:

- Both PC and laptops computers will be available.
- In-person programs will be limited in number of participants (to prevent over-crowding), or take place outside, or continue virtually online .

Library Spaces:

- Plexiglass barriers are in use by staff at circulation desk.
- Seating is available throughout the library.

Safety Precautions:

- Masks will be optional for patrons and staff.
- Disinfectant wipes and/or keyboard covers will be available.
- Laptop computers will be wiped down when returned to the desk.

Materials:

- All library materials will be available to patrons.

Operating Hours:

- Normal hours and staff schedules will be in effect.
